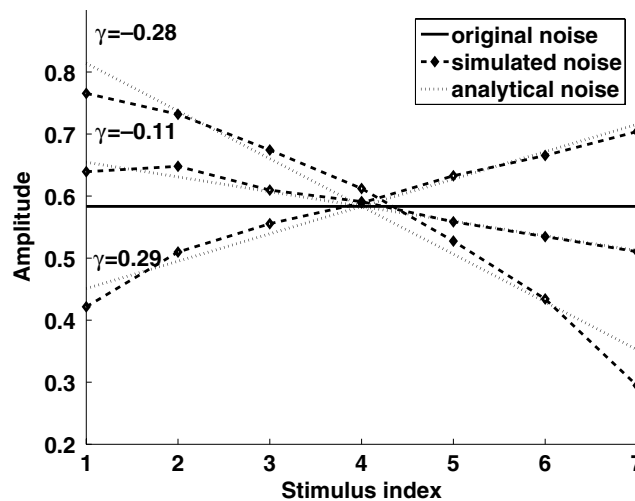


Fig. 5. Examples of noise amplitudes computed analytically and estimated from simulated performances. The picture shows a comparison of noise amplitudes estimated from the simulated data and ones obtained by analytical computation for different values of parameter γ (Eq. (5)). The “true” model is a constant noise model here. The performance for all models presented here is almost identical.
