Student Travel Grant Application

Guidelines for student travel grant applications to attend an the Structural Mass Spectrometry Workshop

1. IMS F & COST will make available an agreed budget for travel grants to students assist attendance at the workshop.
2. For IMS F travel grants student applicants must hold membership of one of the [affiliate societies of the IMS F](#).
3. For COST travel grants students must be from a [COST Member Country](#) .
4. Applications must include evidence of student status; a letter of support from the research supervisor; details of any other financial support; CV and explanation how the student will benefit from the workshop.
5. Grants will be adjusted using a factor based on the standard of living in the student's domestic country and the distance from that country to the venue of the Workshop.
6. The economic factor for the standard of living and the distance will be determined based on accessible public data.
7. The minimum grant will be €100 and the maximum grant will be €750.
8. In the event that the total amount of valid applications requested exceeding the allocated budget, IMS F & COST will rank the grants and fund until the total budget is consumed.
9. The closing date for all applications is midnight (GMT) **April 1st 2017**. Applicants will be notified of the decision by **April 15th 2017**.
10. IMS F & COST will not correspond on their decisions for awarding a travel grant, or the amount granted.
11. Details for receiving payment of the travel grant will be made at the Workshop.
12. All recipients of travel awards must produce a two-page report highlighting the scientific benefits of attendance at the Workshop. IMS F & COST withholds the right to use these reports for publicity and host whole or edited versions on their websites.
