meet@WIS is designed to enhance the experience of WIS conference participants who choose to use it.

Only registered WIS conference participants have permission to use meet@WIS.

Use of meet@WIS requires a username that will be provided by WIS to registered conference participants

meet@WIS includes a list of WIS conference participants. You can always choose not to be shown on the list by going to the conference registration system, logging in, and removing the checkbox to show your name in the list of participants or by contacting us at: contact-us@weizmann.ac.il

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy explains what personal information WIS receives and collects when downloading and using meet@WIS, how and for what purposes WIS uses or transfers such information to third parties.

Information We Receive and Collect

When providing and operating meet@WIS, We receive:

User Information. In order to use meet@WIS the user must provide a 'username' that was provided during the registration process in order to unlock and start using it.

Device and Connection Information. We collect device-specific information when you install, access, or use meet@WIS. Such information includes hardware model, operating system information, browser information, and other device identifiers and IP address.

Use Information. We may collect information about the use of meet@WIS, such as which features you are accessing, administrative and support communications with Us, push notification requests etc.

Log data. When using meet@WIS WIS servers automatically record information that your mobile device sends. This data may include the date and time of your use of meet@WIS, and cookie data (as also detailed below).

Geo-location information. Meet@WIS includes a feature that enables you to navigate the WIS campus using the application 'Waze' - a third party navigation application. When you use such third-party application, their own terms and privacy policies govern your use. In general, We do not collect geo-location information, however the operators of Waze may collect such information subject to Waze's privacy policy and terms of use.

Analytics

We use 'Google Analytics' a web analytics service provided by a third party - Google, Inc. Google Analytics involve the use of cookies* in order to measure the use of meet@WIS and to provide reports for Us. We may also use additional or alternate similar services for same purpose.

*Cookies are small text files created by your device according to a command from our (or our service providers' such as Google) computers.

The cookies for analytical service provided by Google are not intended to identify you personally and their use is governed by Googles' privacy policy. Detailed information about Google Analytics and the use of cookies is published on Google's web site:

Storage and Security

Meet@WIS is operated from servers located in WIS, and all information received and collected (in relation to meet@WIS) is stored on these servers on our data bases.

WIS implements various security measures to secure its servers and to protect the information stored within.

How We Use and With Whom We May Share Your Information

We use or may use all the information We receive and collect: (a) to operate, support and improve meet@WIS; (b) for technical issues; and (c) to assure security (including for investigating suspicious activity).

We do not share the information with third parties, other than with our service providers solely for the provision of their services to us and subject to their undertaking to keep such information confidential.

We may collect, use, and share your information if We have a good-faith belief that it is necessary to: (i) comply with applicable law, regulations, legal proceedings, orders or instructions of competent authorities (ii) detect, investigate, prevent, and address fraud and other illegal activity, security, or technical issues; (iii) protect the rights, property, and safety of WIS, other users or other WIS personnel or others; or (iv) legal disputes or proceedings that We (or any of our affiliates) are involved with.

Manage Your Information

You may delete meet@WIS at any time **however your conference 'username' shall remain valid.**
