This guide is for the Zoom desktop client - Mac or Windows users.

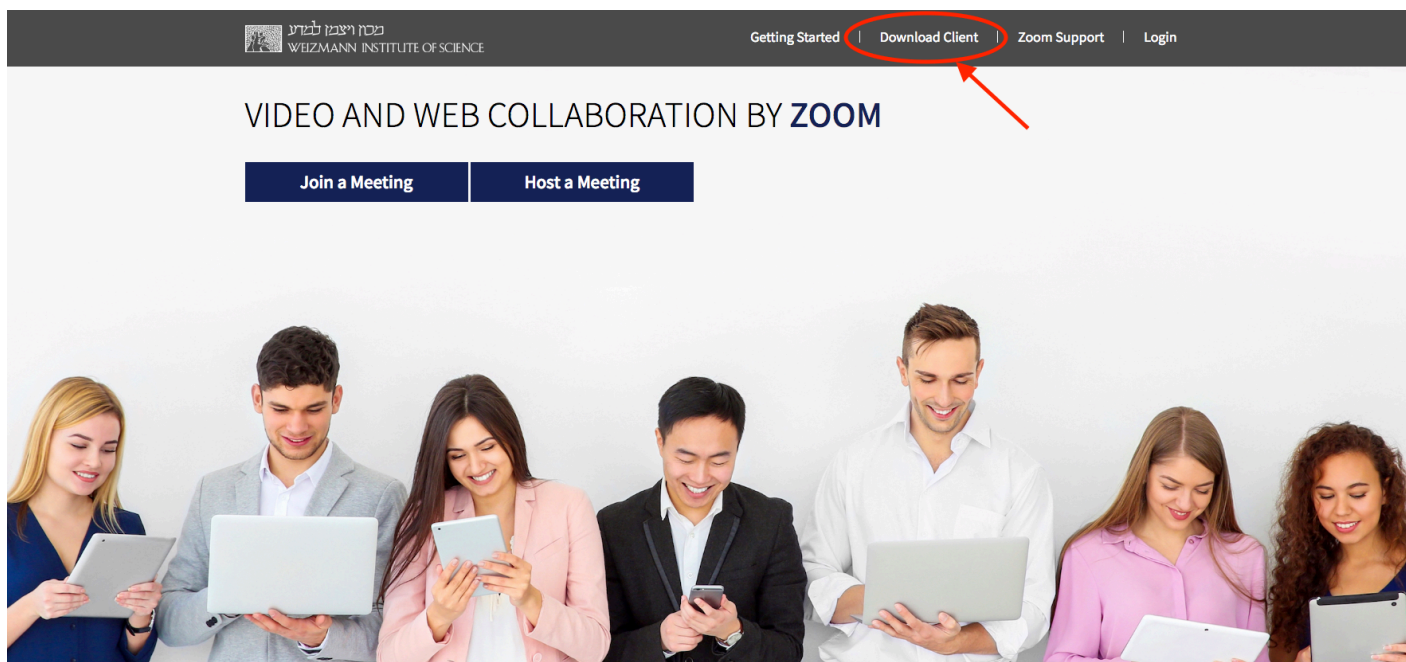
To use Zoom on mobile devices or as web plug-in go to Zoom user guide – mobile devices.

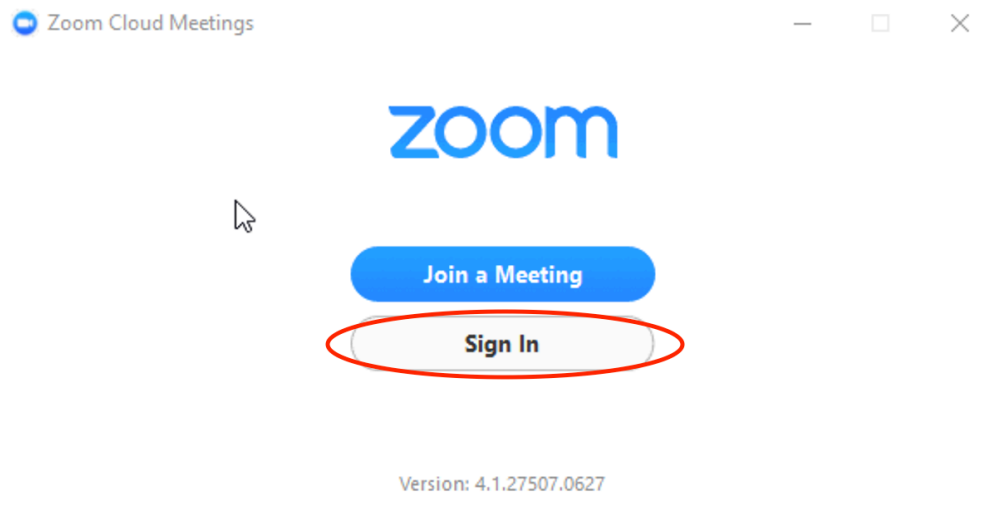
3. Find Zoom.pkg in the Downloads folder, and install it.


Log in and start Zoom


2. Select “Sign in with SSO”

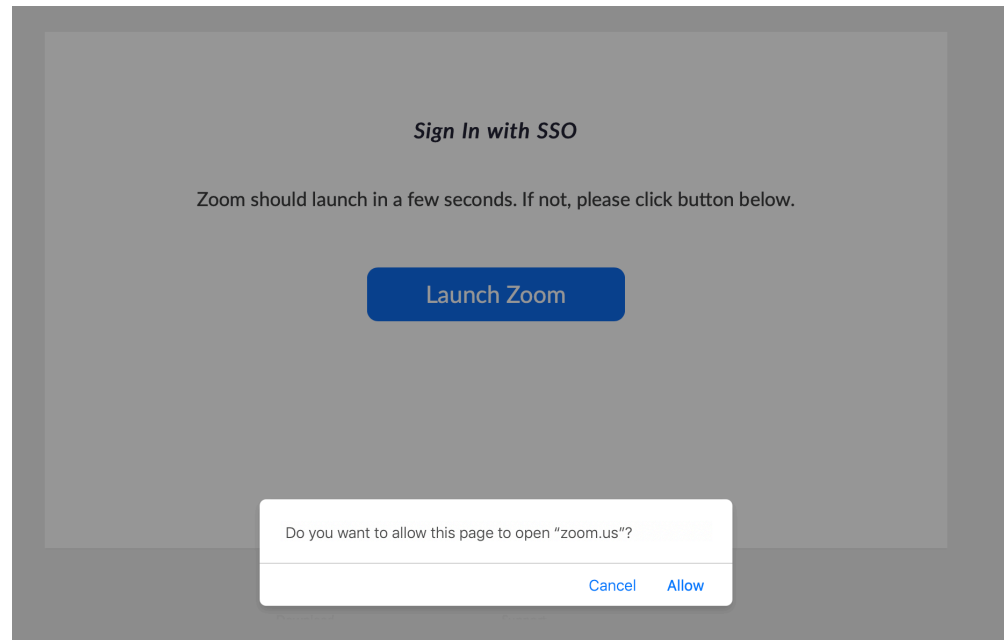
