

# Camillo Golgi 1843-1926

Nobel 1906

Italy



Silver staining revealed neuron anatomy in intact brain.  
Stain penetrated to a small part of the neurons.

Nerves in the brain send controlling signals to muscles  
And receive signals from sensory nerves.

Golgi apparatus, as seen by fluorescent microscopy and by the electron microscope.  
At the center: three-dimensional reconstruction.
