



Rules for Behavior in Case of Fire

- Discovered a fire? Call 2999
- Do not spray water on electrical appliances.
- Do not spray water on burning oil.
Turn the gas off and cover the pot with wet fabric.
- If you cannot control the fire, vacate the area immediately!
- If a fire breaks out in the stairwell, don't exit.
Block the gaps with a wet towel, find the closest window and breathe fresh air.
Try to cover your nose and mouth with wet fabric.
- In a smoke-filled area, crawl on the floor to a ventilated area. When you reach a window, call for help and wait for rescue workers to arrive.
- Do not go into smoke-filled stairwells or use the elevator.
