





Purim Safety Rules

Dear Weizmann Community,

Ensure that costumes and Purim accessories that you purchase comply with Israeli safety standards and are made from non-flammable materials such as synthetic fabrics, paper, cardboard, and plastic.

Avoid using flammable materials, like synthetic fabrics, when making your own costumes. Keep costumes away from fire sources such as stoves, lighters, and cigarettes.

Do not use firecrackers, fireworks, sparklers, or cap guns, and don't use "snow" spray that does not have a standard certification.

Do not hang decorations on light bulbs or electrical appliances.

Ensure that escape routes and exit doors are clear of obstacles and keep escape doors unlocked.

Ensure that fire fighting equipment, such as a fire extinguisher and a fire blanket, are available for use.

Children should be instructed about fire hazards, to keep a safe environment in kindergartens and schools.
