Prize for Volunteering to the Weizmann Institute Community 2024

In celebration of this special year, we, together with the FGS, the Office for Diversity and Inclusion, and the Office of the Vice President for Administration are awarding a special volunteering prize.

We invite you to nominate members of the Institute's community who volunteer for the benefit of community, within and beyond the Institute.

Whether you have been doing this for many years, during times of war and its aftermath, in any field of community service in Israel, promoting mutual support and contribution to others.

The prize is intended for individuals or groups from the Institute community, including students, postdoctoral fellows, scientists, and workers.

Submission guidelines

Any employee/scientist/student/postdoc at the Institute is allowed to nominate a deserving member or a group of individuals from the Institute community for the prize

Submissions should include:

- a brief biography of the nominees - personal background and role at the Institute
- details of the volunteering - where, when, to what extent, and what the volunteering entails.
- letters of recommendation for the volunteers are desirable (if possible)

Selection process

A dedicated committee will review the submissions and select two winners in the individual volunteering category and two groups to be awarded in the group volunteering category.

Prize amount

for individuals: **3,000** NIS
for groups: **7,000** NIS
